

Module 2 is a 3-day advanced level workshop which builds on the foundations of interest-based mediation established in Module 1. Module 2 participants will be introduced to more advanced and sophisticated mediation skills which will increase their effectiveness as conflict resolvers. Role-plays are used throughout the 3 days and those playing mediators will be provided useful individual feedback by a corps of experienced SMC coaches.

- Legal and ethical issues in mediation.
